This Statement of Financial and Other Interests must be filed with the Legislative Ethics Commission on or after December fifteenth and before the following January fifteenth in each year by each legislative employee who receives annual compensation of \$101,379 or less and who is determined not to hold a policymaking position by his/her appointing authority.

**"Regulatory agency" means the department of financial services, state liquor authority, department of agriculture and markets, department of education, department of environmental conservation, department of health, division of housing and community renewal, department of state, other than the division of corporations and state records, department of public service, the industrial board of appeals in the department of labor and the department of law, other than when the attorney general or his agents or employees are performing duties specified in section sixty-three of the executive law.

False statements. Section 73(6)(c) of the Public Officers Law provides that: "Any...legislative employee who knowingly and willfully with intent to deceive makes a false statement or gives information which he or she knows to be false in any written statement required to be filed pursuant to this subdivision, shall be assessed a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars. Assessment of a civil penalty shall be made by the Legislative Ethics Commission in accordance with the provisions of ... section eighty of the legislative law. For a violation of this subdivision, the commission may, in lieu of a civil penalty, refer a violation to the appropriate prosecutor and upon conviction, but only after such referral, such violation shall be punishable as a class A misdemeanor."
